# EOC Update: Evacuation Alert issued Due to Dry Lake Wildfire in Electoral Area "H"

An Evacuation Alert has been issued by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Emergency Operations Centre (RDOS EOC). The RDOS EOC has placed 43 properties under **Evacuation Alert** due to the Dry Lake Wildfire north of Princeton, BC. All properties are all located along Highway 5A in Electoral Areas "H" between McCaffrey Lake, MacKenzie Lake, Dry Lake, Round Lake and Allison Lake Provincial Park.

An **Evacuation Alert** has been issued to prepare residents to evacuate their premise or property in the event an Evacuation Order is issued. The RDOS EOC is working with BC Wildfire to assess the situation. Property owners will be given as much advance notice as possible prior to an Evacuation Order, however residents may receive limited notice due to changing conditions.

Residents and property owners are strongly advised to take proactive measures to prepare for an **Evacuation Order**. Please see the information listed below in this information release. **A full list of properties and map are included in this document.**

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN EVACUATION ALERT IS ISSUED

Upon notification of an **ALERT**, you should be prepared for the Evacuation Order: Locate all family members and designate a meeting area outside the evacuation area, should an Evacuation Order be called while separated.


- Take critical items *only if they are immediately available*:
  - government-issued ID
  - medications
  - eyeglasses
  - cell phones and chargers
  - valuable papers (e.g. insurance, credit, and mortgage information)
  - immediate care needs for dependents
- Prepare to move disabled persons, children and/or neighbors, if assistance is needed.
- If you identify as having extraordinary needs, please contact the RDOS EOC for assistance.
- Prepare to take pets with you and move livestock to a safe area (if possible).
- For pet owners and hobby farmers with concerns for their animals Animal Emergency Response Team (ALERT) can help (250) 809-7152 or email info@alertcanada.org
- Farmers who require assistance, please contact the RDOS EOC.
- Arrange transportation for all your household members.
- Fill the gas tanks of personal vehicles.
- If transportation assistance is needed, contact the RDOS EOC.
- Please store your Firearms in accordance with Section 118 of the Firearms Act.
- Arrange accommodation for all members of the residence, if possible.
- Wait for an Evacuation Order to be issued before evacuating.
- Monitor news sources including signing up for CivicReady<sup>®</sup>.
